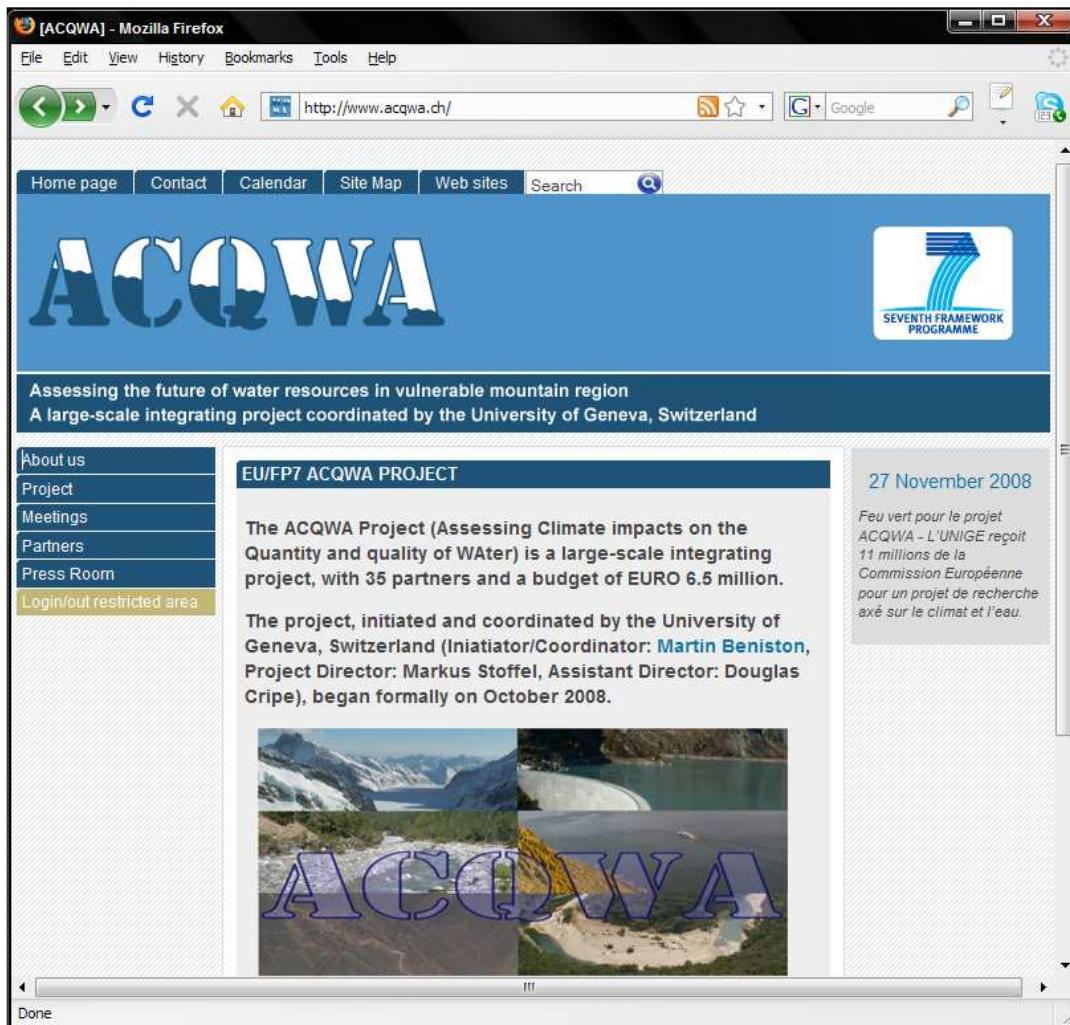

- Restricted area



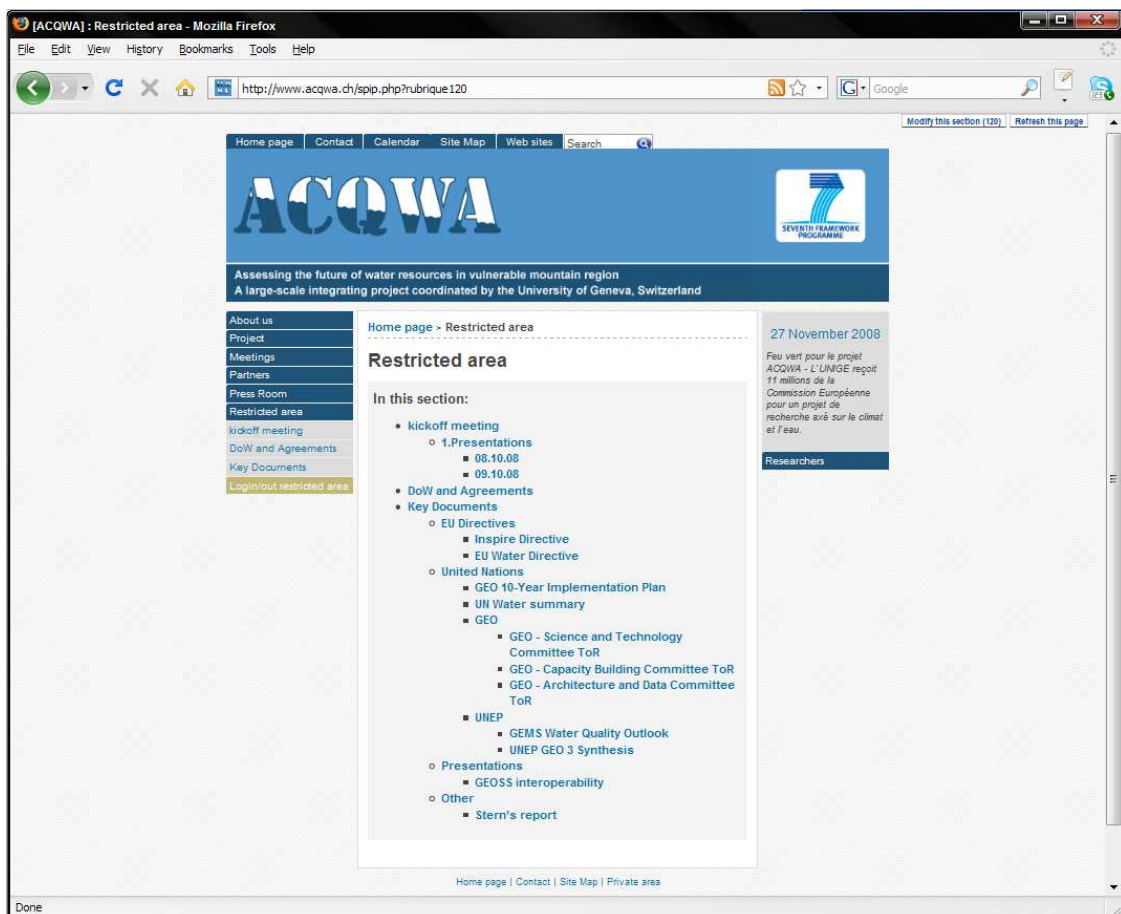

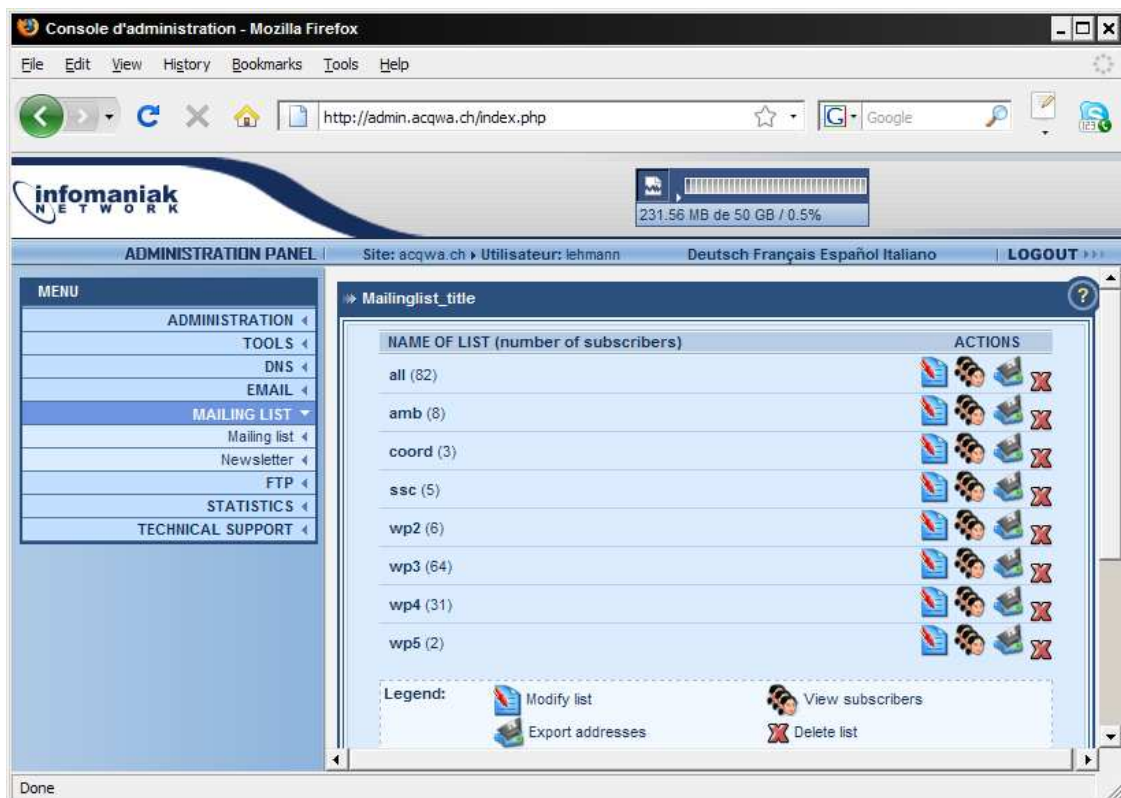
